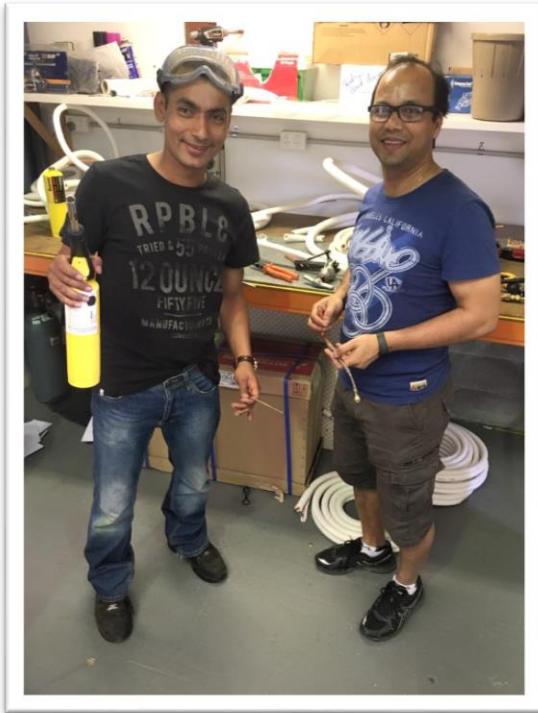

WHAT NEXT?

For Trayn to help candidates get their qualification as quickly as possible we need to first determine that they are eligible for the course!

Course prerequisites;

- Electrical Qualification and experience.
- Air-conditioning experience.
- General Induction Training- White Card

All candidates need to provide the following check list of documents for the **Enrolment Process** prior to the course.

- Copies of your **Electrical Qualifications**/documentation/licence.
- Photo identification**, such as a drivers licence.
- General Induction Training- **White Card**.
- Current **Resume** which shows your electrical/air conditioning work experience.
- Evident of training in the safe operation of an **Elevating Work Platform***.
**If you do not have a EWP licence, we offer training at a discounted rate.*
- Two signed Third Party Verification forms***
**Issued upon request.*



COST

The total cost of this course is **\$1990 for 3 days** of training.

Students are required to place a deposit of **\$1500** and pay the balance on the first day of the course.

What else do I need to do before I start training?

Once booked onto a training course, the following processes will be explained in more detail.

ARC Classroom Trainee Licence

For training, you will need to hold a *Classroom trainee licence* (CL000) from the Australian Refrigeration Council (ARC). This allows you to use the gases and materials needed for the course. The application process is a 2 Phase process including an online application, a submission via post and approx. 5 day processing stage.

This process will need to be explained further and completed once you have booked your course and confirmed training dates.

Unique Student Identifier

For your course you will need a USI number. It's a government issued number to help you keep track of all your nationally accredited training with one identifier.
