### **What is the EWPA Yellow Card Licence?**

Your EWPA Yellow Card Licence is your proof of completing training in one or modules in various types of Elevating Working Platforms (EWPs). At Trayn we offer the 3 most significant and popular modules out of the 5 available on your EWPA Yellow Card; Scissor Lift, Self-propelled Boom Lift and Vertical Lift.

### **Course description:**

The EWPA Yellow Card course is for people using or intending to use scissor lifts, boom lifts, trailer lifts and vertical lifts. We will provide you the required training to be able to safely and efficiently use this type of equipment. You will receive theoretical and practical training as part of this training package. After you have completed the training course, you will receive a Yellow Card Certificate via email which will be valid for 60 days. A Yellow Card with your photo will be sent shortly after (1-2 weeks) to your nominated address.
